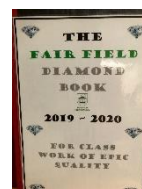

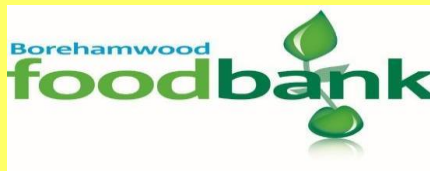
PTA UPDATE Spooky disco
