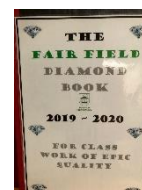

Over the years the books have become such lovely additions to the school library.



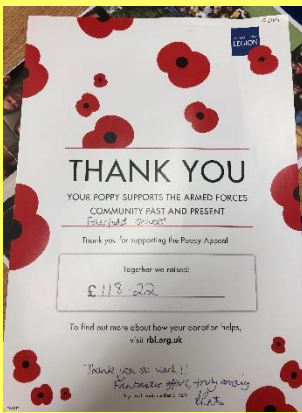
### Lunchtime
