They looked at all areas of school life, with a particular focus on our Writing and History. We are pleased to report that amongst the feedback, we were told there are many systematic strengths at Fair Field including; bespoke marking, good teacher & pupil subject knowledge, evidence of progress & support, well-informed Teaching Assistants and good behaviour and attitudes. They also spoke with pupils, known as "pupil voice" who spoke with articulation about the curriculum in depth, with excellent sentence structure. It was highlighted that children had a strong sense of the impact different civilizations have had from History and the chronological order of the eras.


Tennis

We are VERY excited to let you know about the following opportunity!

For the 6 weeks after half term until Easter the children will be receiving six weeks of tennis coaching at Radlett Lawn Tennis Club. We will transport the children by coach there and back, where they will receive a 45 minute lesson in groups of 10-12 using their purpose built facilities. In the event of adverse weather conditions, we will be able to use the squash courts as a substitute but we remain hopeful for good weather!

As a school we will be buying the children a racket each, which they can keep at the end of the 6 weeks. Radlett Tennis Club will also offer a promotional offer of £5 a week should you wish for your child to continue having lessons there after school.
