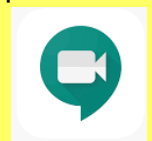

Google Classroom Meetings

We are looking forward to checking in with the children using Google Meetings next week. Some guidance around Google Meetings has been sent to you earlier this week. You will see a timetable of the meetings attached to this email to find out which one your child is in. The meetings will be approximately 10-15 minutes long in groups of 5 or 6 children.

Can I advise you please check that your web browser is up to date and that your computer or laptop camera has access and works. If you are using a telephone device or tablet please make sure you have the Google Meet App as well as the Google Classroom App downloaded with your child's account set-up. The app looks like this.



The link to the Google Meeting will be available half a hour before the meeting is about to start in the classwork area (it will also pop up on the stream as a new material). Open the message and click on the link and your child will join the meeting. If this doesn't work copy and paste the link into a new tab. There is an instructional video in the classroom for guidance.

If your child isn't able to attend the meeting please email the class email address for further information. If your child doesn't come to the meeting a member of staff will call you to check in and see if they are able to join a future meeting.

Once the meeting has ended, do not rejoin the meeting. The link will disappear and new links will be sent for future meetings.
