Dear Parents and Carers.

We're back! Well technically we have never left, with staff taking care of children at St John's; planning and delivering our remote learning; preparing learning packs; getting the school ready for our return; compiling and delivering care packages and much more. This Monday we received staff training, either through Zoom or by socially distancing ourselves so we all felt fully prepared. Then, 73 days after the last child left Fair Field for lockdown, we returned with 27 Year 6 students and 22 children in Key Worker School. Numbers have risen slightly over the week and today we sit at 33 Year 6 (61%) and 24 children in Key Worker School. We are proud to have the children back – educating our children and keeping them safe and happy.

Thank you to all those who came to collect their third home learning pack this week, we thank you for maintaining momentum with home learning. Some of you were able to collect PE kits too, please don't worry if you didn't we will be keeping them safe. If you were unable to collect the pack and would like to next week, please email the office a time you would like to come in.
