Recreation area

Aldenham Parish Council has produced a plan for the recreation ground and over the next eighteen months it is looking to invest heavily in facilities and the look of the recreation area. They would like to have some input into our ideas from the pupils and parents of the school and have a closer relationship with us

For example they have the following actions to take place over the winter/spring of 2020/21 and wonder if the pupils/teachers wish to be involved

- Spring time bulbs to be planted near the Multi Use Play Area
- Bird boxes to be installed in the wood, as well as recording use
- 210 trees (whips) to plant

We will be putting a team together to volunteer. If you have any ideas for the area or can offer help you can add them to the stream on the library.

- The competition will be virtual - so judging will be based on the submitted video.
- The performance can be any genre, no longer than 3m30s etc.
- The judging criteria is attached
- Costume is not required - and will not play any role in the judging.
- There will be competitions for KS2 lower and upper
- There is a maximum number of entries from a school of 5. One from each house and one from Mrs Goodwin.

Entry Procedure

- The initial entry must be submitted to a house captain by **FRIDAY 9th OCTOBER at 5pm.**
Let your teacher know
- The video deadline is **Friday 6th November.** The video needs to be the finished piece. We will add a folder to Google Classroom or we can video for you in school
- Videos should **not** include graphics, titles or other identifiers with pupil or school name. All we will need is the participant number. This is part of our child protection and GDPR policy.
- The videos will only be seen by us and the judges and not used on any website / social media etc.
- Entries must come via the school. You cannot send an entry direct to the competition.
