Current Covid Guidance

Changes to latest Government guidance on PCR testing and reminder about close contacts and self-isolation

People self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative on both day 5 and day 6 and do not have a temperature, from Monday 17th January.

Individuals who are still positive on their rapid lateral flow tests must stay in isolation until they have had 2 consecutive negative tests taken on separate days.

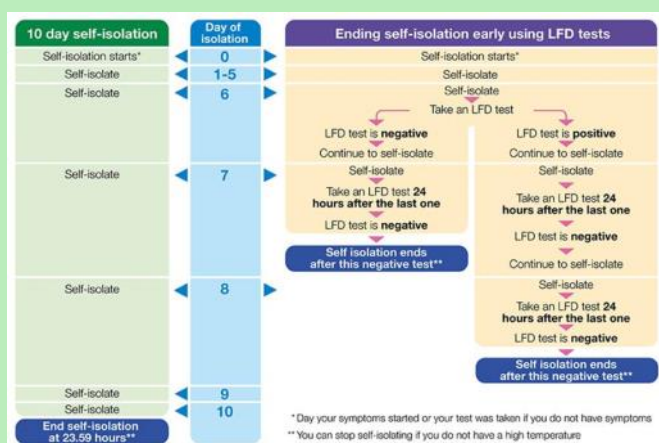
People with symptoms, even if they test negative using an LFD should still book a PCR test at: www.nhs.uk/gettested

Please remember self-isolation means stay at home. If a parent or carer, or other member of a child's household is self-isolating because they have COVID-19, they should not be dropping or collecting children at school.

From 11th January in England people, including children in Year 7 and above and children 5 and over who are testing daily as close contacts, who receive a positive lateral flow device test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and won't be required to take a confirmatory PCR test. Adults who are fully vaccinated and children aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 should take a lateral flow device (LFD) test every day for 7 days instead of self-isolating. Daily testing by close contacts will continue to help to slow the spread of COVID-19. Close contacts are not asked to get a PCR test unless they have symptoms or are requested to by NHS Test and Trace.

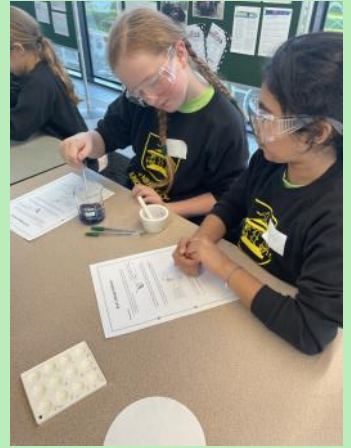
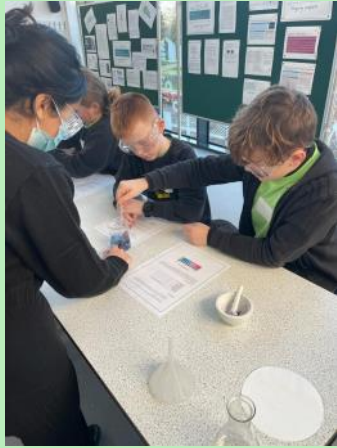
