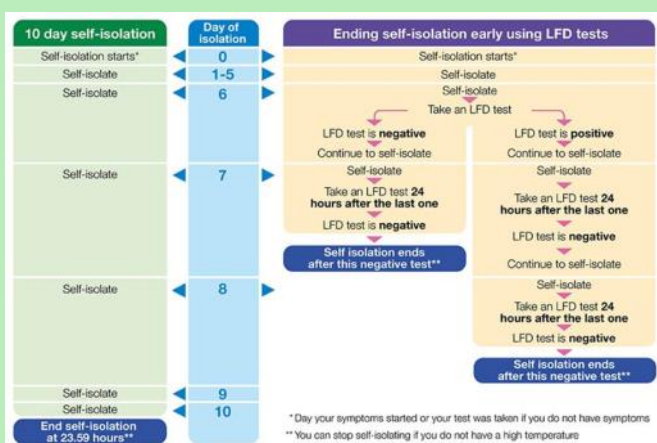
World Thinking Day
