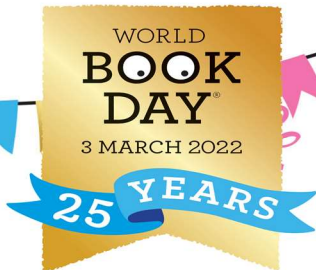

Dear Parents,

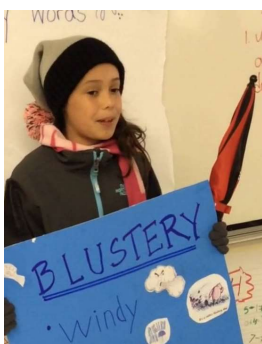

Building on this focus of vocabulary, this year, instead of dressing up as a book character, we are having **A VOCABULARY PARADE!**

Does your child have a favourite word or can they use the dictionary to find an unusual or very descriptive word? Have they found a brilliant new word in a book you have been reading?

We want the children to come to school on THURSDAY displaying this descriptive or extraordinarily amazing word.

They could have a sign around their neck, a hat with the word on or dress up as the word. Google 'vocabulary parade' for a plethora of other ideas. A describing word would work better than a noun so for example, if they wanted to come in their football kit, they could be 'skilful' rather than 'footballer'. If they fancied coming in a Harry Potter costume they could be 'courageous' or 'determined', rather than 'magician'
