The Consortium Test Preparation Support Information

Whilst the 11+ doesn't form part of the curriculum we recognise that the schools within the consortium are in close proximity to us. As such, we would like to offer some support for children to prepare for the verbal reasoning test. We are therefore offering parents the chance to sign up to a **25 week course of verbal reasoning preparation**, which will be run by Mrs Parkinson. Your child will be expected to complete the whole course.

For children who have already been preparing, classes will run from 8.00-8.45am. for those new to the process, there will be classes running after school from 3.10-4.00pm.

The children will familiarise themselves with the types of questions and be exposed to a wide range of vocabulary. Nearer the test, they will focus on test practise.

After half term, they will be provided with a book to work from and a folder to keep all their work in. There will be an expectation that they undertake follow up work through the week to consolidate what they have learnt.

The course is priced at £75 and payable in 3 termly payments of £25.00. If you would like your child to have a place, please sign up on Gateway. If you would like to discuss the cost, please approach me directly.

On Thursday 6th July, we will be holding a mock test for any child that wishes to take part. There is no charge and we will return the scores the following week.

In addition, Year 5 now have access to a balance and agility course on the field to use during lunchtimes on Mondays, which we hope will be of benefit for those who may be considering the Queen's Sports Test.

The PE Aptitude Test is for applicants to Queens' School only. Owing to the overwhelming response to this test, we stress that only those with exceptional sporting ability and who live within our catchment area (WD3-WD7, WD17-WD19, WD23–WD25, AL2 (South of M25), HA6, HA5 3**, HA5 4**, HA3 6**, HA7 3**, HA7 4**) have a realistic chance of achieving a place through this route.

Children who have a sibling who will be attending Queens' School at the time of admission need not apply for this test.

As a school we can advise if we feel your child is a suitable candidate and can write references for children who immerse themselves in curriculum and extra-curricular activities (competitive and participation)
