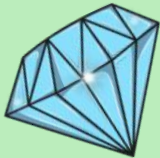

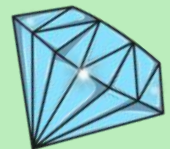

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## Why did we celebrate World Smile Day?

World Smile Day honours commercial artist Harvey Ball, who created the smiley face in 1963 to increase the morale of the employees of a life insurance company. As the smiley face went on to become the most recognised symbol of goodwill and happiness on the planet, Ball became concerned about the over-commercialisation of his symbol. He thought it lost its true meaning. He came up with World Smile Day in 1999 to devote one day each year to smiles and kind acts throughout the world. Today, we wanted to use the day in the way Harvey intended, to put a smile on the faces of all at Fair Field Junior School.
