Accelerated Reader

We ask that children complete an accelerated reader quiz once they have finished reading either a book online, from home or from school. This helps to monitor their understanding, how regularly they are reading, the difficulty of the texts they are being exposed to and the variety of genres.

The quiz which they take records the amount of words they have read, level of understanding and provides valuable reports for our staff. The children will then be awarded a number of points based on the difficulty and length of the book. Each week, we hold a celebratory assembly highlighting the amount of points each class earns. The class with the most amount of points/books read at the end of each term is the proud owner of our reading trophy. In addition, we celebrate children who have read the most words with certificates each term.
