### Christmas Gifts & Fair



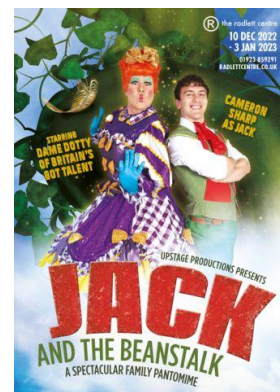
