Pease can I remind all parents and carers that, whilst children can use the alley alone to enter the school site, parents & carers should be bringing their child to the bottom of the alley and ensuring they are on the school site before leaving. Children (apart from Year 6) should NOT be coming to school alone. Alternatively, you can walk the alley with them. Equally, children should not be dropped off in cars at the back gate or left from the other side of the road. The turning circle should be used if you wish to drop and go, remembering it is left hand turn only. Once they are on site, either at the front or the back of the school, members of school staff are present as they head to class.


