- ▶ Questions/concerns.

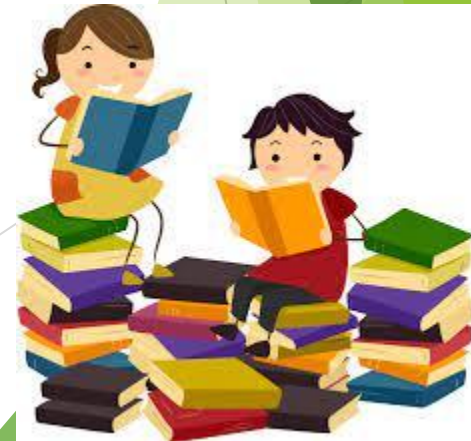


# Stop & Read



## What it looks like at Fair Field

Reading at Fair Field is important. We aim for all children to develop a love for reading so for that we are introduce Stop & Read sessions during snack time. During this session, Class Teachers will read a class text for the children.



# Home Learning



Every week the children will either receive Reading, SPaG or Maths homework. It is given out on Thursdays and should be handed in on Tuesdays.

Spellings are given on Friday for a test the next week.

Please read and practice spellings daily.

Reading Records need to be signed by an adult at least 3 days a week.



# Home Learning

Children also have a Times Table Rockstars account and are expected to spend at least 30 minutes per week on Times Table Rockstars in order to develop rapid recall of their timetables. Pupils will miss 10 minutes of their breaktime on Fridays if they have not completed their TTRS homework, to complete in class.
