- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (with a taxable income below £16,190 and not receiving Working Tax Credit)
- Pension Credit (Guarantee Credit)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Working Tax Credit during the four weeks immediately after employment finishes or after starting to work less than 16 hours per week
- Universal Credit (household income under £7,400 after tax, excluding benefits)
