Updated Behaviour Policy

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to update you on our revised Behaviour Policy, which we introduced to the children in assembly yesterday.

The key changes are the introduction of clear reminder steps and consistent consequences. These give children a predictable structure so they always know what is expected and what will happen if behaviour begins to interrupt learning. The system is particularly designed to help us address persistent low-level behaviours—such as calling out, chatting, or off-task behaviour—which can affect the learning of others.

Our stepped approach includes:

- Reminder – A gentle prompt to support children in making better choices
- Warning – A clear signal that behaviour needs to change
- Consequence – A short reflection period, restorative conversation, or another appropriate action

Although the steps and consequences are clearer, our approach remains firmly restorative. Children are guided to reflect honestly on what happened, repair harm where needed, and learn from their mistakes. This supports the development of our school values:

- Honesty in recognising actions
- Inclusion so everyone feels safe and able to learn
- Respect for others' learning and wellbeing
- Forgiveness as children make amends and move forward
- Perseverance in making better choices next time
- Kindness in restoring relationships

We believe these changes strengthen consistency across the school while reinforcing the values we want every child to carry with them. Our aim is a calm, focused environment where everyone can learn without interruption.
