Notes:

1. The “expected” standard is a score of 100 or more and the “higher” standard is a score of 110 or more
2. The average progress score is a measure of progress between the end of KS1 and the end of KS2 compared to pupils with similar KS1 results in other schools. It is known to be typically lower for junior schools than for all other primary schools.
